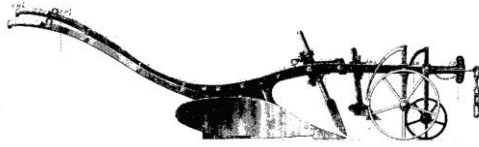

### **Terms and Conditions – Trade/Craft Stands**

The Trustees of the Prickwillow Engine Museum CIO and The Directors of TWH Clarke & Son (1954) Ltd will not be liable for damage to or loss of stock howsoever caused, and all exhibitors are urged to take out their own suitable insurance. **Exhibitors should carry their own public liability insurance**, and where appropriate **product liability insurance**, as required by law. A copy to be made available at time of payment for the stand/ or for inspection at the show (unless a prior arrangement about insurance is made with the organisers - contact Pauline Dunham before applying if you wish to discuss this)

The cost of the stands is kept as low as possible, and although there is no specific stipulation this year, we trust stall holders to make an extra donation to the charities if they have a very successful show - with takings of more than 10x the deposit charge. This way we can avoid increasing costs for all.

Application for stands in specific positions will be considered sympathetically but no such request shall be deemed binding on the organisers. Priority will be given to 2 day exhibitors.

Stands can be set up on Friday between 1pm and 6pm, or from 7am on Saturday (7.30am on Sunday)

When setting up stands, vehicles, not being used as part of the stand, must be removed from the vicinity of the farm yard to the designated car park areas by 9.30am on Saturday and Sunday, and dressing of stands completed by 10.00am.

Please stow all boxes and packaging away safely and clear of all gangways and alleyways.

When dismantling stands, vehicles will not be allowed back into the farm yard at the end of the festival until permission is given by the stewards when they deem it is safe to do so.

Personal electricity supply in the barn and Museum: All electrical items to be connected to the electric supply shall have been safety tested and certified within the previous twelve months and shall be warranted by the exhibitor to be free from any defect. Kettles and heaters are not permitted unless supplied by the organisers. In the interests of safety should the power supply system become overloaded it shall be within the organisers discretion to request any exhibitor to disconnect from the supply. Electricity supply is not generally available for outdoor stands.
