100 Club Rules



Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds for the Prickwillow Engine Museum to support its policy to conserve and maintain its exhibits and update displays. After deduction of any administrative expenses all profits will be available for the use of the Charity, registration number 1185003.

The Club will have a start date of 1st May 2021.

Rules

1. For the cost of £5 per month (£60 per year) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. You can have more than one entry and each subscription will be issued with a separate number. The numbers will remain valid to the members for as long as the subscription is paid.
2. The 100 Club is a small society lottery (registered with East Cambridgeshire District Council under licence number 21/00078/LOTT) and is open to all supporters aged 16 years or over.
3. Payments are to be made by monthly standing order on the 1st of the month, or annual standing order from 1st May, or by annual cheque. Your commitment should be for at least a year and one month's notice given for cancellation of the annual subscription.
4. If a member misses a payment date by one calendar month we will assume they have cancelled their membership and reserve the right to sell the number to someone else.
5. The total prize fund for the year will be equivalent to 45% of the annual income. Although the target is for 100 subscriptions, the club can operate on much lower numbers – however, the more participants the greater the prizes.
6. A draw will take place every month when there will be 3 prizes. The first prize will be 20% of the monthly income, second prize 10% and third prize 5%. The first draw will take place on Tuesday 25th May 2021. Members numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
7. In addition to the monthly draw a further draw will be held during the twelfth month (April) with two additional prizes – one at 7% of the annual income and one at 3%. Members will only be eligible for the full value of any annual prize after they have been a member for twelve months. If less than twelve months any prize will be proportional to the number of months of membership.
8. The draws will take place with at least 3 people present – including a minimum of one trustee and one volunteer of the Prickwillow Engine Museum CIO. In case of any dispute the decision of the trustees is final.
9. The winning cheques will be posted or delivered by hand to the address on your membership application form, normally within one week of the draw. It is your responsibility to let us know if your address changes.
10. The surname and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Museum website and social media accounts (unless the winners wish to remain anonymous, as indicated on the original membership form, when only the winning membership number will be declared).
